- ♦ Hosted many prestigious events including the NSW Open Championship and qualifying for the Emirates Australian Open.

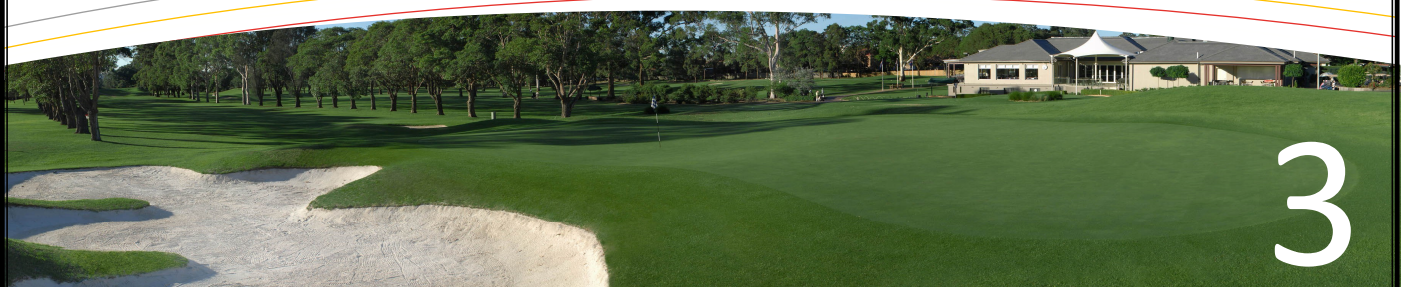
Golf Shop:

Tudor Room

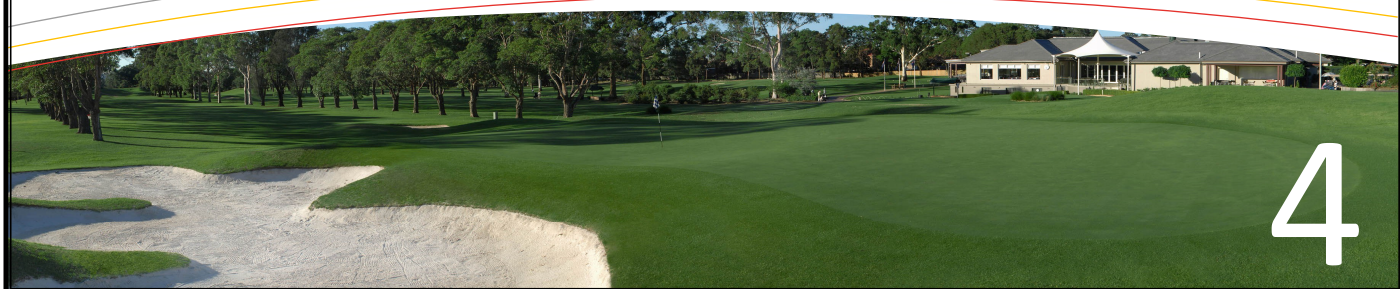
- ◆ Seats up to 220 - ideal for large corporate events, weddings, birthdays and other celebrations

Partner (Playing rights: Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday & Sunday)

Entrance fee (select your option):

Partner membership only applies if spouse/partner is a Full Playing or Six Day member.

Non-Competition Playing (limited to 100 members)

Entrance fee: Nil

Membership subscription: \$1,750 pa

- 1) 7 days playing rights after competition.
- 2) Friday Open Competition is permissible with visitor's competition fee.

Other categories:

- 1) **Intermediate 3 (Age 30-34) - 7 days playing rights;** No Entrance Fee; Membership subscription \$2,865 pa
- 2) **Intermediate 2 (Age 25-29) - 7 days playing rights;** No Entrance Fee; Membership subscription \$2,150 pa
- 3) **Intermediate 1 (Age 21-24) - 7 days playing rights;** No Entrance Fee ; Membership subscription \$1,110 pa
- 4) **Colt (Age 18-20) - 7 days playing rights;** No Entrance Fee ; Membership subscription \$930 pa
- 5) **Junior (Age 14-17) - 7 days playing rights;** No Entrance Fee ; Membership subscription \$475 pa
- 6) **Cadet (Age < 13) - 7 days playing rights except Sat morning;** No Entrance Fee ; Membership subscription \$235
