**LOCAL RULES**  
(TO BE READ IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE RULES OF GOLF)

- OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 27-1)**
  - Those areas beyond the course boundary fences.
  - Beyond any line of white stakes with black tops.
  - Beyond the concrete wall adjoining the motel property.
  - Beyond the black line surrounding the Clubhouse and the Golf Shop.
- GROUND UNDER REPAIR (RULE 25)**
  - Those areas the margins of which are defined by white stakes and/or white lines. **Note:** Stakes defining GUR are Immovable Obstructions.
  - Except in a hazard, clearly defined wheel marks and/or ruts made by a mower, tractor or motor vehicle.
- GROUND UNDER REPAIR – PLAY PROHIBITED**  
Those garden beds identified by white stakes. **Note:** All other planted areas are an integral part of the Course from which the ball must be played as it lies or declared unplayable (Rule 28).
- EMBEDDED BALL**  
Through the green, a ball which is embedded in its own pitch-mark in the ground may be lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to where it lay but not nearer the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green.
- STAKED TREES AND SHRUBS**  
If a staked tree or shrub interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the ball **MUST** be lifted without penalty and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2b(i) (Immovable Obstruction). **Note 1:** If the staked tree lies in a water hazard, the ball **MUST** be dropped in the water hazard or the player may proceed under Rule 26. **Note 2:** The stakes are Immovable Obstructions.
- WATER & LATERAL WATER HAZARDS (RULE 26)**  
Water Hazards are defined by yellow stakes and/or lines. Lateral Water Hazards are defined by red stakes and/or lines. **Note:** The stakes are Immovable Obstructions.
- ROADS AND PATHS (RULE 24-2)**  
Artificially surfaced roads and paths (including gravel) are Immovable Obstructions. All other tracks and paths that are not predominately surfaced are integral parts of the course from which the ball must be played as it lies or declared unplayable (Rule 28).
- FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS**  
All fixed sprinkler heads and top covers are immovable obstructions. If a ball lies through the green and such an immovable obstruction on or within two club lengths of the putting green and within two club lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief as follows: The ball shall be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay that (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids intervention, and (c) is not a hazard or on a putting green. The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.
- DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES (DMD)**  
A player may obtain distance information by using a DMD that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a DMD that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, windspeed, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.
- STONES IN BUNKERS**  
Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions (Rule 24-1 applies).
- PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES**  
Stroke Play - 2 strokes/Match Play - Loss of hole
